We continue to amplify the need for policies to conserve old-growth forests nationally. OGFN is diligently working alongside the Climate Forests Campaign, a group of 120 like-minded environmental organizations, to push for these forests to have lasting federal-level protections. As the only nation-wide non-profit organization solely focused on old-growth forests, we are thrilled to stand with so many partners in this important effort.

With our new Network Manager, Nick Sanchez, a Certified Forester, we are developing and sharing information on finding, protecting, and caring for old-growth forests with land managers, forest owners, and citizen activists. Since Earth Day of 2022, we have been patiently awaiting the federal definitions and inventory of oldgrowth and mature forests across Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management lands. On this year's Earth Day, those reports were released to the public.







178.5 million acres of forest

of this area is protected


Of the almost 178.5 million acres of forest across BLM and USFS lands, 18% has been identified as old-growth (32.7 million acres). Half of this area is protected from logging as Wilderness areas or Roadless areas, but the other half is not. *We are working to change this!*

The Old-Growth Forest Network has joined the national Climate Forests Coalition (climate-forests.org) to push for stronger, lasting protections of these older forests because they are worth more standing. The USFS and BLM have requested input from the public on how these forests should be managed. OGFN, the Climate Forests Coalition, and our networks of supporters wrote to these agencies during this past spring's public comment period to call for these precious forests to be set aside from logging.

Hopefully next year we will be able to give the update that they heard our call and created policies to protect our oldest forests.

Our goal is to strengthen the connection between these treasured forests and the communities that surround them. 
