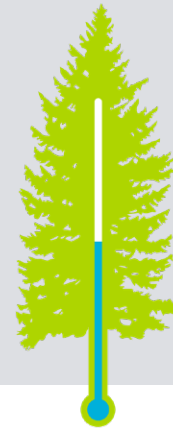

# CLIMATE FORESTS

Since Earth Day of 2022, we have been patiently awaiting the federal definitions and inventory of old-growth and mature forests across Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management lands. On this year's Earth Day, those reports were released to the public.

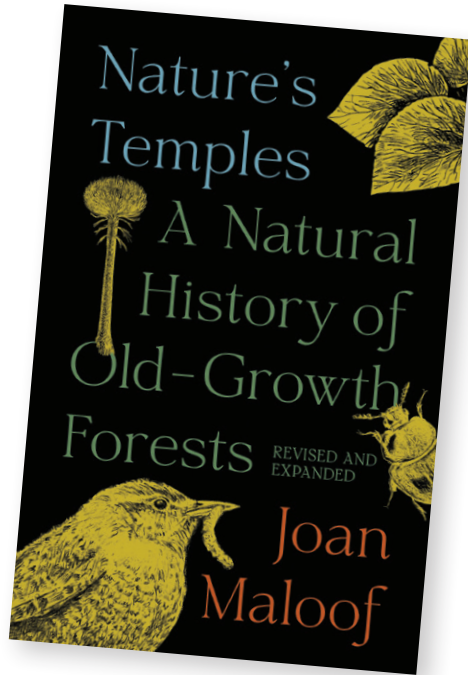
Of the almost 178.5 million acres of forest across BLM and USFS lands, 18% has been identified as old-growth (32.7 million acres). Half of this area is protected from logging as Wilderness areas or Roadless areas, but the other half is not. **We are working to change this!**

The Old-Growth Forest Network has joined the national Climate Forests Coalition ([climate-forests.org](http://climate-forests.org)) to push for stronger, lasting protections of these older forests because they are worth more standing. The USFS and BLM have requested input from the public on how these forests should be managed. OGFN, the Climate Forests Coalition, and our networks of supporters wrote to these agencies during this past spring's public comment period to call for these precious forests to be set aside from logging.

Hopefully next year we will be able to give the update that they heard our call and created policies to protect our oldest forests.

We are also donating one copy of *Nature's Temples* to the library systems of our first 200 counties with forests in the Network. Our goal is to strengthen the connection between these treasured forests and the communities that surround them. If you don't yet have a Network forest in your county, ask your local library system to add *Nature's Temples* to their collection!

Saving forests and strengthening our love of old growth has been the focus of the organization. Thank you to Joan—and now Sarah—for the passion and leadership to reach 200 forests and 6,000 supporters.

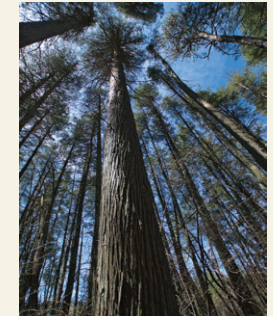

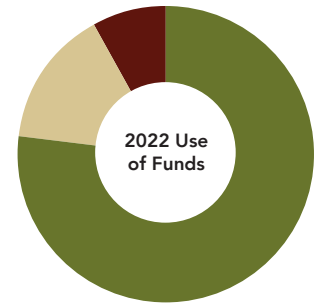
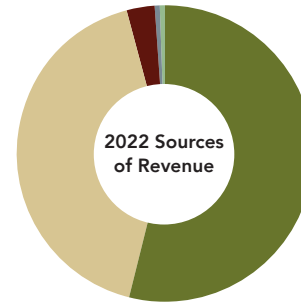
